Question Title 2. Choose One of these Community Life Projects for ARPA Funding

- Develop a community center by upgrading existing community building(s).
- Upgrade Town website.
- Create a fund for community arts, recreation spaces and events.
- Establish local farmers, crafters, artists markets.

Question Title 3. Economic Sustainability: Choose One of these for ARPA funding

- Fund support for local child-care.
- Purchase and renovate property in Newfane for economic development and housing.
- Provide recovery relief for local businesses.
- Promote local businesses, arts, farms, recreation and tourism.
- Create a business incubation space.

Question Title 4. Housing Access: Choose One of these for ARPA Funding

- Fund incentives for creation of affordable and accessible long-term housing, in individual homes and appropriate-scale multi-dwelling units.
- Implement a water quality study in villages to access need for community septic.

Question Title 5. Transportation: Choose One of these for ARPA funding

- Establish bus service to connect Newfane residents with work, school and services.
- Establish bicycle and walking infrastructure.
