SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 30, 2020

The legal voters of the West River Modified Union Education District (the "District"), comprising the voters of the towns of Brookline, Jamaica, Newfane, and Townshend for prekindergarten through Grade 12 are hereby notified and warned to meet at their respective polling places on Tuesday, **June 30, 2020**, at 9:00 a.m. at which time the polls will open and 7:00 p.m. at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot on following article regarding the grades PreK-6 school budget:

Article 1: Shall the voters of West River Modified Union Education District #U072A approve the school board to expend \$ 5,778,979 for grades PreK-6 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$ 20,372 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 9.88% higher than spending for the current year.

The legal voters of the West River Modified Union Education District are further notified that voter qualification, registration, and absentee voting relative to said annual meeting shall be provided in Chapters 43, 51, and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

Upon closing of the polls, the ballots shall be transported and delivered to Leland & Gray in the Town of Townshend and comingled and counted by members of the Boards of Civil Authority of several towns under the supervision of the Clerk of the West River Modified Union Education District.
